Lions Club Seregno AID, by November 27, 2020, received the applications from the Organizations participating in the selection for the "Water is life!"

The proposal benefiting from the funding was identified by obtaining the maximum score in the evaluation grid published together with the call.

The suburbs of Ouagadougou, the capital of Burkina Faso, are growing rapidly due to the rural exodus caused by poverty and terrorism. In this context, conditions of marginality arise, especially for young girls (14-18 years) forced to live by expedients in the big city. In the village of Beoogo Tienbo ("Hope for tomorrow"), the KEOOGO association helps girls regain self-esteem and undertake professional paths, including those related to agronomic activity.

Access to water intended for people and crops is essential within this project. The well and the water treatment and distribution network are the works to be carried out within the "Koom la vim" project, to directly favor fifty women included in the Beoogo Tienbo program, indirectly one hundred children from the village nursery school who will benefit from agricultural products and potentially 53,000 families from surrounding villages.
